The Will County 2011/2012 Earth Award Celebration will be held on Wednesday, May 9, 2012, at Billie Limacher Bicentennial Park in Joliet. The park is located at 201 West Jefferson Street. The celebration will run from 10:30 AM until 12:00 PM. Dave DiNaso's Traveling World of Reptiles will give a 40-minute presentation that may include hands-on opportunities for your students. Some school groups bring lunches to eat in the park after the program.
