Sustainability Award

On November 9, Will County was given the Illinois Governor's Sustainability Award for the County's numerous efforts to improve recycling, conserve open space, reduce energy consumption and educate both the business community and school students on the importance of making "green" choices. This award is the highest recognition a business or governmental organization can receive in Illinois. Established in 1987 as the Pollution Prevention Award, it now encompasses far more environmental efforts. Will County's website, green roof, landfill-gas-to-energy facility, conservation subdivision ordinance and household hazardous waste collection programs were all part of the recognition.

Expanded Electronic Recycling

Will County Partners offer 13 Drop-Off Sites

As of January 1, 2012 there were 17 different electronic devices banned from disposal in Illinois. All of them and more are accepted in the Will County recycling program with host communities:



- Village of Bolingbrook
- Channahon Township
- Forest Preserve District of Will County Laraway in Joliet
- Forest Preserve District of Will County Monee Reservoir
- Godley Park District
- Village of Homer Glen/Homer Township
- City of Lockport

If that isn't possible, gift cards are low impact since they come in recyclable wrapping, usually get used to purchase an item truly needed and are easy to mail! If you know the person well, you may know which store to purchase the card from but it not, mall cards, restaurant cards and stores catering to their occupation are often appreciated.

Of course children love to open toys and you may have already gotten a unique item that needs wrapped. In this case, consider a reusable bag that can be used for shopping year round. They make an extra gift as a special wrapping. There are also gift boxes that come pre-decorated. These are used in movies and TV shows, where beautiful ribbons are not cut or paper ripped, the lovely box just opens. That box can be reused for years and always looks terrific.

- Metal Tools (power tools, drills, screwdrivers, hammers, saws, sanders, wrenches, pliers, clamps, wire cutters, etc.)

Solar Powered Bus Shelter

Mass transit is already well known for cutting air pollution by lowering the number of vehicles on the road. Some are running on biodiesel fuel, which



burns more cleanly than diesel, further reducing green house gases. In 2014 PACE will be purchasing Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) buses to further reduce emissions. However, the latest improvement by PACE, introduced first in Will County, are shelters powered by solar. This allows lights to be powered by the sun, addressing safety and environmental issues. The one in the photo is in Plainfield and there are more throughout the county, with additional solar installations scheduled beyond our boarders!
